

## CAMP EBENEZER REGISTRATION FORM 2025

## Begins Monday, June 30, through Friday, August 1, 2025

Camp Ebenezer, a FREE five-week Children/Youth Summer Enrichment Program, offers a unique opportunity for campers to develop and increase their knowledge and understanding of the Bible, English, Math, Black History, Science, Computer, and the Arts (Music, Crafts, etc.). The program also includes free meals (breakfast, lunch, and an afternoon snack) and exciting weekly swimming sessions at the Christi Recreation Center. There is an annual nominal nonrefundable registration fee of \$60 per camper.

Weekly swimming sessions will be offered at the Christi Recreation Center, and the cost is included. Additionally, the optional weekly trips are on Wednesdays at an additional cost. The trips are being finalized but are estimated to be slightly higher than last year, due to inflation, around \$200 per camper for six trips.

The Program begins Monday, June 30th, through Friday, August 1, 2025. Camp is available for Children and youth ages 5 through 14. *The camp's capacity is 36 campers and will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Registration must be completed with the full registration fee and a signed application.* 

The registration period for the Camp Ebenezer Summer Enrichment Program is from April 24 to June 22, 2025. Parents/Guardians are required to complete the registration form on the reverse side of this form and return it to the address below, or complete the online registration at "ebenezertemplepc.org" along with the non-refundable registration fee. Families with three or more siblings (brothers/sisters) will pay a reduced fee of \$150. The application and fee can be submitted via our website, **ebenezertemplepc.org**, **via Cash App (\$ebenezertemplechurch)**, or in the form of a check or money order to:

The application is incomplete without the required registration fee.

Note: A \$10 late fee applies to any registration received after Jun 15, 2025

Attendance at one of the mandatory orientations is crucial for parents. These are scheduled on Saturday, June 21, 2025, at 11 AM or 1 PM, or Thursday, June 26, at 7 PM. Please note that no camper will be admitted without a parent attending an orientation. (Campers aged 5 require extra clothing in case of an accident – please place the camper's name on clothing and bag, and bring it to the orientation)

Please mark your calendar and plan now to attend Camp Ebenezer's closing ceremony on Thursday, July 31, 2025, at 3:00 p.m. Children/Youth will have a performance hour and an Arts & Crafts show.

We look forward to providing your child/Youth with an invigorating and memorable summer experience!

**Notice:** There will be six classes, and class sizes are limited to 5-6 campers per class. Therefore, acceptance is on a first-come basis.

Parents must keep campers home and notify the staff of COVID-19 symptoms or contractions.

<u>Swimming attire</u>: females – one-piece bathing suit; males – official swim trunks. Note: campers should wear swim attire on swim days (Monday and Friday); pack a towel, water shoes, sunscreen, and undergarments.
